

SOCIALIZED TUITION SYSTEM (STS)

The Socialized Tuition System (STS) shall replace the Socialized Tuition and Financial Assistance Program (STFAP). Similar to STFAP, the STS prescribes the tuition rates applicable to undergraduate students who will enroll in AY 2014-2015. To determine these rates, students must log-in to STS Online (sts.up.edu.ph) using their PINs (for Freshmen and New Students) and UP Accounts (for Upperclassmen). Please take note of the following application/appeal schedule in June and July 2014:

FRESHMEN AND NEW STUDENTS

- June 2-8 - STS Application period for UP Visayas only (June 2014 Batch)
- June 9 - Release of STS Application results of June Batch
- June 2-15 - STS Appeal period for Freshmen and New Students (April, May, and June 2014 batch)

UPPERCLASSMEN

- June 2-8 - STS Application period for UP Manila, UP Visayas, and UP Mindanao
- June 9-15 - STS Application period for UP Cebu and UP Los Baños
- June 16-22 - STS Application period for UP Baguio and UP Diliman
- June 23-24 - STS Application period for UP Manila, UP Visayas, and UP Mindanao
- June 25-26 - STS Application period for UP Cebu and UP Los Baños
- June 27-28 - STS Application period for UP Baguio and UP Diliman
- June 30 - Release of STS Application results of Upperclassmen
- July 1-21 - STS Appeal period for Upperclassmen

Accounts for New Students and Upperclassmen

NEW STUDENTS

All new students will use their Student No. and 5-digit PIN to access STS. New students include the following:

- UPCAT Qualifiers
- Incoming freshmen with newly issued Admission Slips;
- Incoming freshmen with Admission Slips who were not able to log-in to STS during the April 2014 application period due to log-in problems;
- Incoming freshmen with Admission Slips who signified their intent not to apply in STS during the April 2014 application period but have requested to apply to STS due to special circumstances [cases to be evaluated by ODSA / OSA / OSSS whether to allow student to apply];
- Incoming freshmen who deferred enrolment in previous years;
- Incoming MD [from UP College of Medicine] and JD [from UP College of Law] students;
- Transferees from other schools; and
- Students without Admission Slips but have been duly accepted by a UP unit as an incoming undergraduate student.

Your 5-digit PIN should be included in your Admission Slip. If you were not issued one, then you may request for your 5-digit PIN from the STS Helpdesk (OSSS/OSA) in your campus. Please refer to the STS Helpdesk tab for contact details.

UPPERCLASSMEN

Upperclassmen will use their UP Mail account (e.g. jpdelaacruz@up.edu.ph) to access STS Online. There is no need to request for a 5-digit PIN. UP Mail is a new e-mail service that will consolidate all UP employees and students from all Constituent Universities (CUs) into a single e-mail domain.

If you're from Diliman, you may get your account from the eUP helpdesk at Room 308, 3/F Vidal A. Tan Hall, UP Diliman, Quezon City. If you're from another campus, you may visit your respective Computer/IT Center for assistance in getting your username and initial password. Just be ready to present your latest Form 5 and UP ID for identity verification.
