
SHIFTING TO A NEW DEGREE PROGRAM

Any UPV student who has finished at least 15 units can apply to shift to a different program, as long as they meet the requirements for the new degree program and there are slots in the program theywant to shift to. [Dean's authority to sign has been delegated to the College Secretary per Memo No.FN 90-68 dated 08 August 1990]

Graduate Program Advisers and Coordinators should keep in mind the maximum residence rule (MRR) when assessing a graduate student's request to shift to a new degree program. This is because the counting of residency starts at the time of the student's initial enrollment in the UP System. As a result, when calculating residency, the number of years the student has been in residence while earning his/her first degree will be considered. It is important to keep students from switching to a different degree program if they cannot complete the program within the residency time limit.
